




This guide is a general overview of how to take our product apart for easier transport. These steps will work with many of our styles, however, actual style will vary slightly from the images in this guide




Step 1: Remove Cushions



Step 2: Flip on Back




Step 3: Remove Legs

Step 4: Remove Bottom Cloth




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A cutting tool may be needed if bottom cloth cannot be removed by hand

Replacement cloth may be requested


Step 5: Remove Back and Seat Nuts of One Side



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7/16" socket or wrench needed for this step. Leave arm In place


Step 6: Remove Seat Nuts of Opposite Side




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7/16" socket or wrench needed for this step.


Step 6: Remove Arm



Step 7: Remove Seat




Step 8: Remove Nuts of Inside Back
